

What mental health professionals need to know about people with intellectual disability

It can be hard for people with intellectual disability to find mental health care that meets their needs.

Experts at UNSW made two resources to help mental health professionals:

1. A manual that says what patients might want and need.
2. A toolkit with ideas to improve mental health services.

About the manual

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The manual has information and skills health professionals need.

It says how to:

- Learn what your patient can and can't do
- Communicate in ways your patient can understand
- Get help from carers and other supporters, if your patient says this is ok
- Use supported decision making
- Give patients information they can understand
- Work with other people who can help, like disability professionals
- Work with other organisations that can help
- Get help from experts
- Learn more about intellectual disability mental health
- Think about your own beliefs and attitudes.

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The toolkit can help improve health services. It has ideas:

- to change clinical practice
- to help service managers include everyone
- to help health professionals understand and work with people with intellectual disability
